Susan Brownell Anthony is best known for her involvement with the women's suffrage movement. She was very committed to social equality and also petitioned.

Born on February 15, , in Adams, Massachusetts, Anthony grew up in a politically active family. They worked to end slavery in what was called the abolitionist movement. Along with activist Elizabeth Cady Stanton, Anthony founded the National Woman Suffrage Association in
